## ***Chủ tế:***

4. For all members of our parish community – that we may pray with the sincerity of the tax collector, aware of our need for God's grace, and grow in humility and generosity in our life of faith. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
5. In silence, let us present to the Lord our personal intentions... May He graciously receive all these heartfelt prayers, together with the mass intentions offered by our community, and grant eternal glory to the faithful departed. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
