4. For our parish community, may the Lord teach us to live the spirit of "Blessed are the poor in spirit," trusting in His power and mercy in every circumstance of life. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
5. In a moment of silence, let us offer our own intentions... we also pray for whom this Mass is offered, and for all the faithful departed, that they may share in the glory of God's Kingdom. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
