Chủ tế: Brothers and sisters, on this Second Sunday of Lent, God the Father revealed Jesus as His beloved Son and commanded us: “*Listen to Him.*” Trusting in God’s saving love and transforming power, we humbly present our prayers before Him:

1. For Pope Leo XIV, our bishops, and all the clergy, that like Peter, James and John on the mountain, they may listen to the Beloved Son and lead us through Lent’s trials to resurrection glory. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
2. For civil authorities and world leaders, that inspired by Abraham’s faithful obedience to God’s call, they may foster justice and peace, filling the earth with the Lord’s steadfast love. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
3. For those burdened by suffering, temptation, or fear – like the disciples overcome on the mount, that Jesus may touch them, saying, “*Get up and do not be afraid,*” bringing healing and hope through his abolish death. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
4. For our parish community, that like the early believers, we may live in unity as Christ’s Body, each member caring for one another, strengthened by the Transfiguration’s light to journey faithfully through Lent. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
5. In a moment of silence, let us offer our own intentions... we also pray for whom this Mass is offered, and for all the faithful departed, that they may share forever in the glory of God’s Kingdom. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
