4. For our parish community: that each of us may live our faith sincerely, becoming salt of the earth and light for the world, so that through our words and actions, God may be glorified. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
5. In a moment of silence, let us offer our own intentions... we also pray for whom this Mass is offered, and for all the faithful departed, that they may share forever in the glory of God's Kingdom. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
