4. For those who are blind in body or spirit, the sick, the disable, and all who live in the darkness of suffering, that they may encounter Jesus and receive His healing and consolation in body and soul. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
5. In a moment of silence, let us offer our personal intentions to the Lord... We also remember for whom this Mass is offered and all the faithful departed, that they may share in the eternal joy of God's Kingdom. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
