4. For all parishioners of our parish community, that they may show their love for the Lord not only by words, but also through the life of faithfulness, charity and generosity in our families, ministries, and parish activities. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
5. As we celebrate the end of the school year, may the Lord bless our students for their hard work, keep them safe during the summer, and help them grow not only in knowledge, but also in wisdom, faith, gratitude and love. We also pray and be grateful to the parents, teachers, catechists, TA, and all who have guided the students throughout the year. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
6. In silence, let us now take a moment to offer the Lord the prayers in our hearts... May the Lord graciously receive these intentions, and the intentions of this Mass, and may all the faithful departed be welcomed into the Kingdom of God. ***Let us pray to the Lord.***
